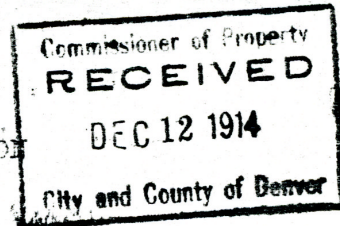


MOUNTAIN PARKS ADVISORY COMMISSION
